- a. Referee Clinics

1. *Accreditation Clinics:*

- i. *Dates for the clinics will be posted on the Aloha Region website for sign-up. Working to secure sites – McKinley HS – Hirata Hall and Immaculate Conception Church.*
- ii. *Clubs are welcome to secure a site and host a clinic. Basic requests – 1) a white board/screen; 2) no conflict with practice before or after. Once arranged, we will provide the contact person with the respective handouts for distribution. Estimated time of clinic is 2 hours.*

- iii. *Clinic fee remains at \$40.00 per team. Payable at the start of the clinic.*

2. *Certification*

- i. *The AH will maintain its decision requiring that a certified rostered adult serve as the R2 at all age divisions when participating in any AH event. When faced with a multi-court assignment, one of the officials must be the certified rostered adult.*
- ii. *We are also aware that some clubs have players who are very good officials and who want to officiate. We welcome them and will work with them. However, it does not displace the rostered Adult requirement. Clear with the assigned day official.*
- iii. *All travelling teams are required to have a certified scorer (SC). While the recommended minimum is two. The teams are allowed to establish their own minimum.*
- iv. *The 2019-20 certification curricula have been submitted for review and publication via USAV Academy. Certification information will be posted on the AH junior website.*
- v. *Requesting that all practical evaluations be scheduled prior to April 30, 2020.*

- b. Rule Changes

1. *The 2019-21 Domestic Competition Rules (DCR) has been published (volleyballreftraining.com)*
2. *There are a number of rule changes for this season. Coaches and players should be aware of the changes; along with this season's points of emphasis.*
